## Assignment 7

## **VISUALIZE A DATABASE**

Bulletin 2 (Contact list) is a database in table form. For each member it shows 8 pieces of data:

first name
gender, male or female (usually implied by first name)
surname
matriculation number
academic year, 1 or 2
programme (clasVEM etc.)
email (and perhaps website) address
mobile number.

This assignment asks you to display some of this data – not as a table but more graphically (2D image) or plastically (3D).

- 1 Choose 12 people from Bulletin 2, including yourself. All must have a different first name
- 2 Discover their cities of birth (by emailing or phoning them?). If you can't: fabricate the answers
- 3 Make a database table showing, for each member:

first name gender academic year city of birth

- Design a way of displaying this data (but <u>no other information</u>) more visually either in 2D (e.g. paper or a screen) or as a 3D construction. The display must be <u>static</u>: not interactive, or moving or changing over time
- 5 On one or more A3 sheets draw (or construct) your design
- 6 Write your full name (nome e cognome) on your display
- When you arrive at the next lesson, immediately fix the display to the wall and be prepared to explain it to everyone.

This is primarily a visual design assignment, not a research assignment. You are designers, so please be <u>inventive</u>.
