

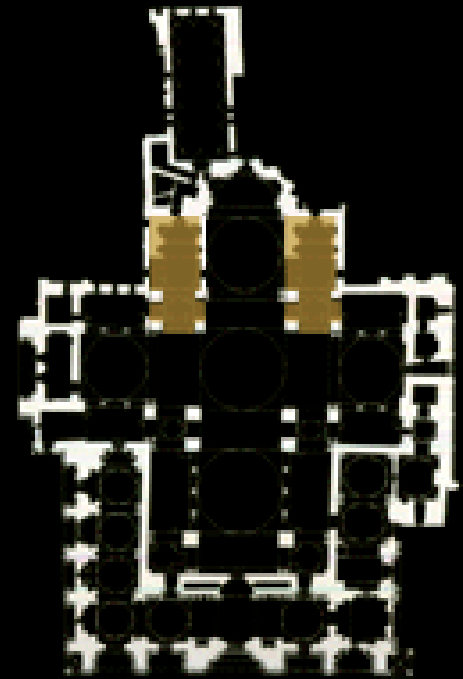

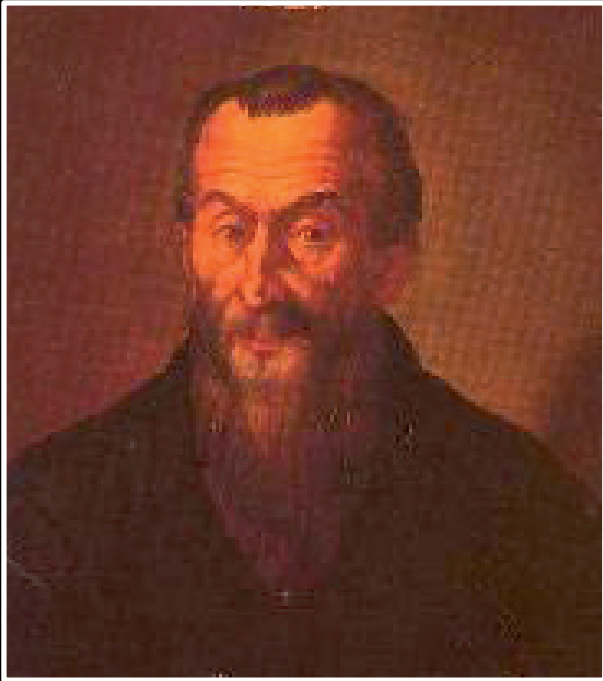
INFORMATION

Coro spezzato

A term used to describe the division of musical forces into musically and spatially distinct groups. It is associated particularly with polychoral music written by composers in Venice in the mid-16th century. The contrasting groups engage in a musical dialogue, in phrases of varying lengths and degrees of overlap.



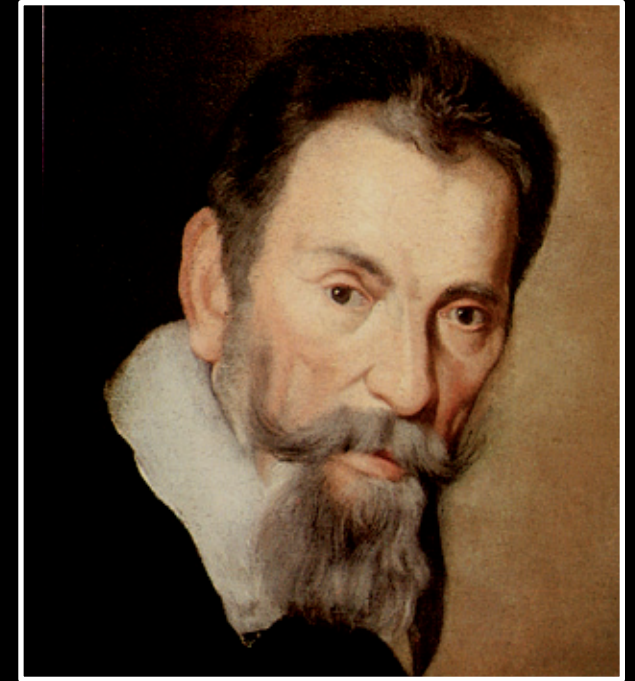
